Triple P – Positive Parenting Programme is one of the most effective evidence-based parenting programmes in the world, backed up by more than 35 years of ongoing research. Triple P gives parents simple and practical strategies to help you build strong, healthy relationships and confidently manage your children's behaviour and prevent problems developing. The option of on-line modules is also available with this particular programme.
