Change the World and Children in Need



Last Friday we used Children in Need day to encourage our children from year one to year six to look at how they could change the world. We challenged the children to think about, discuss and focus on one aspect they would like to change. After an input from the teachers the only ceiling on the children's learning was their imagination. The children did not disappoint!

The children worked in mixed age groups and this gave them the opportunity to work with children they haven't worked together before; help nurture each other's ideas; promote collaboration and communication as well as encourage them to be more curious of the world around them. Throughout the day the children created different ways to promote their ideas, which ranged from film making to poems. In addition to encouraging the children to become



curious and enquire about the world around them, the children were engaging in many



of the subjects in the National Curriculum.

After the children spent the day planning, creating and communicating their ideas, some of the groups had the opportunity to share their thought processes and ideas to the rest of the school. Some of the children's ideas included; pipes with a filter to ensure that areas with a water shortage has purified water; Bully Monster, which helps sorts our issues by placing

bullies in a web; Eco Mobile, which uses renewable energy and cuteness to power it. Also it stops pollution without losing power and 'street cred'. One group focused on combating food shortage across the world, two projects which focused on ensuring everyone has the chance to be educated as well as creating drones, which reduces litter.



The range of issues the children wanted to combat was admirable and it was clearly evident that they enjoyed the day. Also the children responded positively, imaginatively and proved that they are very thoughtful of children not so lucky.
