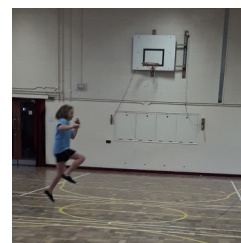
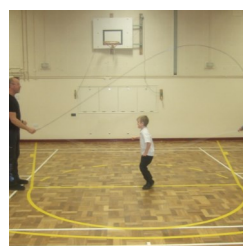

1914, Ernest sets sail in Endurance with 28 men to Antarctica because he wanted to be the first to reach the South Pole. Unfortunately they became stuck in pack ice, and the ice kept getting taller and taller and water! Then Endurance

Sank, from the pack ice! Then they had to camp on the cold, freezing ice until sight of clear water, so they could set sail again. Then they set sail to Elephant Island and they stayed there for a bit.

Sleeping on Elephant Island

A wife said "Oh I do hope the men are ok!" Men took a small boat to the Whaling Station, the men also stayed at the Whaling Station for a while. Shackleton and 2 others had to walk across icy mountains to get to the Whaling Station, it took them days and nights to travel.

36 hours to reach it, which is a day and 7 hours. Three months until they could get back to Elephant Island. 20 months later all 28 men are rescued. Although they suffered they lived a happy life.
