Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to the new academic year, it has been great to see the children settling in and engaging in their work. As you may be aware two teachers have joined us; Miss Rawlings (Year 2 & Key Stage One Leader) and Mr Neary (Year 3/Beech). Also we have two Teaching Assistants join us, Mrs Dallyn (Rowan Explorers) and Mrs Wilson (Beech). In addition to this Mr Mead will be continuing working with children in year two, five and six throughout the year.

I would like to thank all of the children and parents for adopting our new policy encouraging the children to become more independent. Year One and Two children say their goodbyes at the class door, whereas all of Key Stage Two children say goodbye at the fence by the climbing frame. Please can everyone support us with this.

During this term we are focusing on reading and promoting the love of books. In Key Stage Two a new initiative will be starting next week and in Key Stage One we will be continuing with the Reading Rockets. Whatever the age of your child it would really benefit them if they read, or were read to, every day for around ten minutes. Raising the standards in reading will benefit every area of the curriculum.

Homework is an integral part of school life and set homework will start next week. Homework is a great way for parents to gain an insight into what the children are learning in their lessons as well as the children sharing their new found knowledge. On our website is the Calculation Progression and it will outline how we are teaching calculation in school.

Also on our website you will find what the yearly expectations are in reading, writing and maths are for your child. These objectives are what they will be striving to do independently throughout the year.

We are always looking for adults to listen to readers, develop the children's maths skills or assist with our Forest School visits. Therefore if you would like to volunteer in school, please pop in and see me.

We are really excited about what is happening in school, what we have planned and how we are going to challenge each child to reach their full potential. With your help our children will enjoy and excel and be ready for the next step of their learning journey.

Climbing Frame

During the school day we have a rota for the children to access the climbing frame. The children do not have to change their shoes to play on the climbing frame unless we feel their footwear is unsafe. On these occasions we will ask the children to put their plimsolls on. During these sessions the area will be monitored by an adult. If you choose to allow your child to use the climbing frame after school please can you supervise your child as we will not have a member of the teaching staff available.

Key Stage One Nativity

This year our Key Stage One children will be performing the Christmas Nativity or at least their own unique twist of the story. The dates for the performances are Wednesday 8^{th} December and Thursday 9^{th} December, both will start at 1:30 pm.
