#### Maple Class

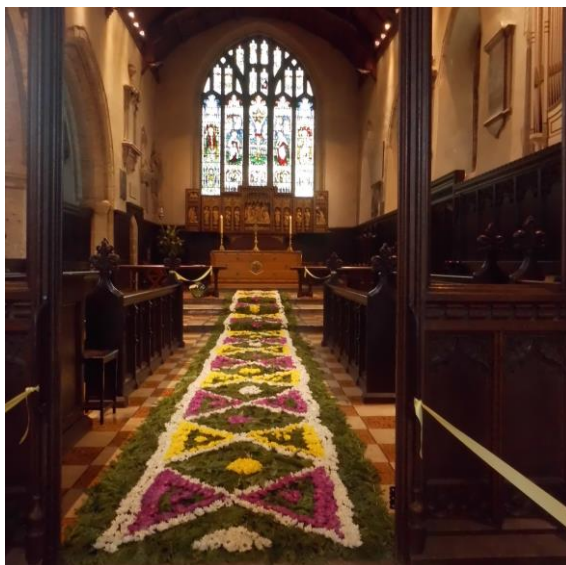
Maple Class topic this half term is The Romans. We have been writing myths in literacy and in art; we have been looking at a popular Roman pastime, still life painting.
