As you may be aware there is a planning application for a housing development to erect 34 dwellings on land at Rotherlea, Dawtrey Road, Petworth, West Sussex, GU28 OEA. The planning application indicates that there will be less parking for people in South Grove due to allocated parking spaces for the new dwellings and vehicular access to a parking area. This will impact on parents dropping off and collecting children. Maple Cello Assembly


