On Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May at 2.30pm the children in Beech and Maple Class will be performing their poetry.

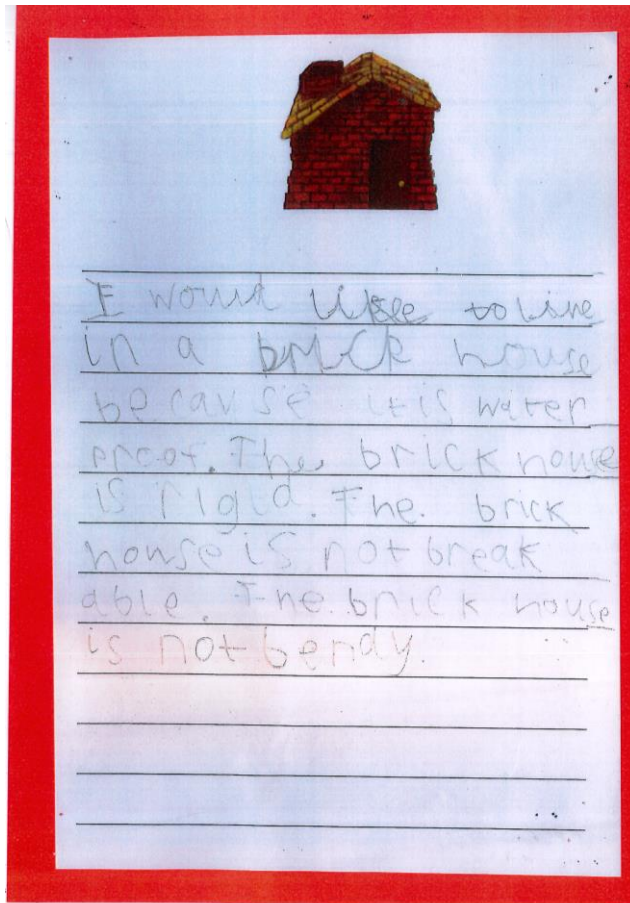
### Collective Worship

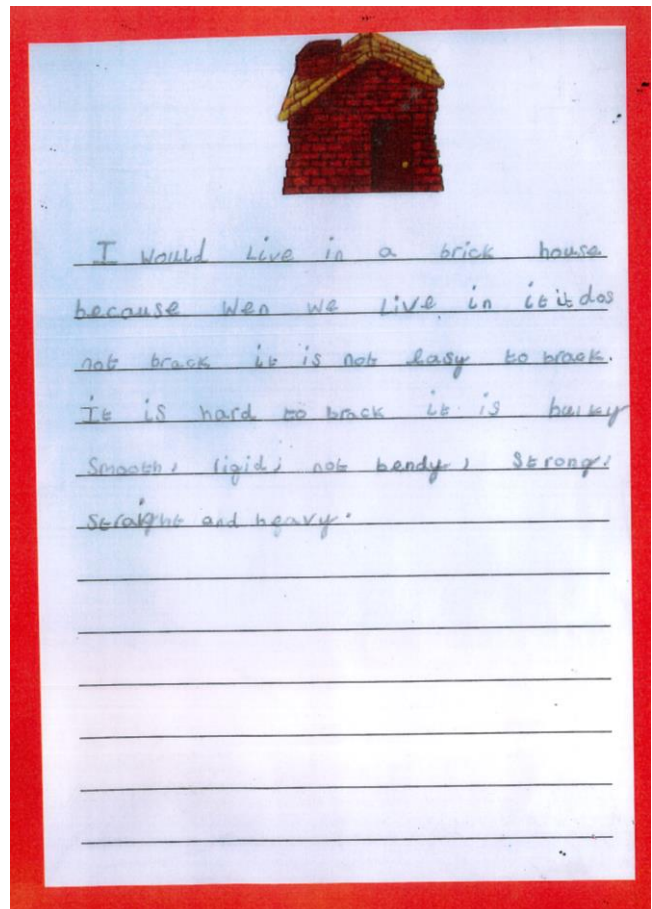
## Children's Work

In Science we have been discussing materials and their properties whether and they would live in a straw/stick or brick house.

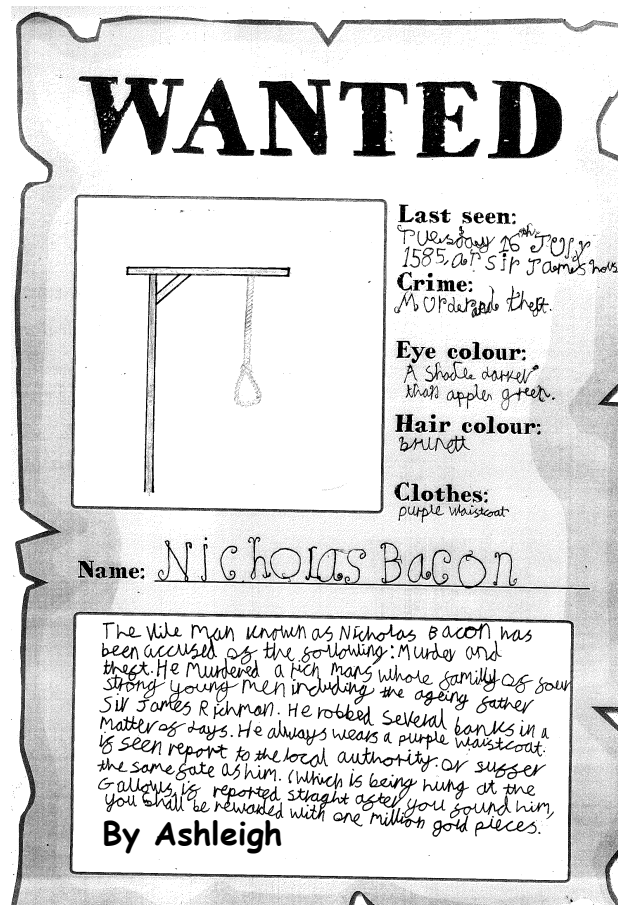
